TEIFI VALLEY TRAIL

A unique trail of diverse landscapes following the Teifi River from its source at Teifi Pools in the Cambrian Mountains; through Cors Caron, a national nature reserve; through woods and farmlands to the Teifi River's mouth.

This trail is an ideal way for communities to promote their local businesses, attractions and accommodation to walkers eager to enjoy the wildlife, heritage and culture of the Teifi Valley.



THE FUTURE IS CIRCULAR

The Celtic Circle will join together the Teifi Valley Trail, the Welsh Coast Path and other established footpaths to complete a much anticipated circular route of 170 miles of excellent walking.


