



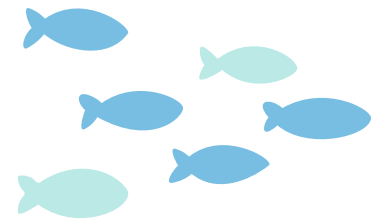
# TAITH AFON

These materials can support you as you design, plan and implement your curriculum, or provide a fun and engaging additional activity!

Each workshop is designed as a stand-alone lesson or as a sequence to provide a cohesive learning experience. Our recommended completion order is as follows:

1. Your River Journey (30 mins)
2. River Ecosystems (1 hour- Inside)
3. River Catchments (1 hour - Inside)
4. River Health (1 hour - Inside)
5. River Monitoring (1 hour - Outside)



For each workshop, you're provided with: a workshop plan, including a step-by-step guide, kit list and preparation instructions; learning slides for visual learning displays, and, for those workshops that require outdoor learning, a risk assessment template.

 Speech bubbles indicate a potential question that may be appropriate for the learners. Look for the symbols below at the top of each resource for an indication of whether the workshop was designed to be completed inside or at the riverside:



Some workshops have additional 'stretch' activities for you to take the topic further, aimed at Year 7 & 8. However, these resources are a guide only; you know your learners best, so please adapt your approach depending on your learners' needs and interests.
